UK holidays

If you live in England and Wales and are registered with a GP you can obtain oxygen for holidays on the NHS by ordering through your surgery.

Please allow 2-4 weeks for arrangements to be made.

My destination

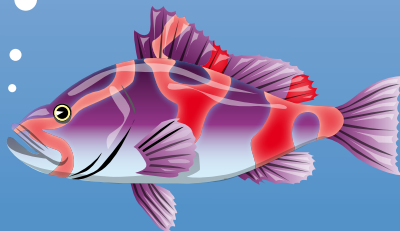
If you are expecting a delivery you must inform the hotel or holiday site where you are staying. They may have rules in place for deliveries that we will need to know.

Information we require

If you need oxygen while you are on holiday, we need to know the full address of your holiday destination, the dates you are away, the name of the person who has booked the holiday, the reference booking number and a phone number on which we can reach you.



Travelling by car

Oxygen needs to be transported safely, if in doubt keep your cylinders upright. Remember to tell your car insurance company that you will be carrying oxygen.

Travelling by coach / rail / ferry

Please contact the company concerned and let them know in advance that you will be travelling with oxygen.

Holiday insurance

Please contact your insurance company to let them know you will be going on holiday with oxygen.

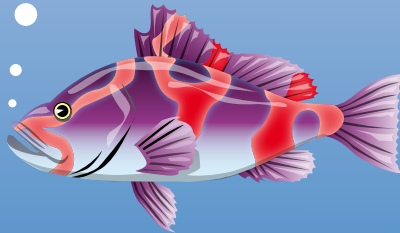
Flying

If you are planning to fly as part of your holiday, you should be assessed by your GP as to whether this is suitable for you.

Please contact the airline to confirm their policy on handling oxygen and what paperwork, if any, they require.
